

## CHATEAU MARTILLAC Loupiac



### PRESENTATION

This luxurious castle acquired by Mr DUCAU's family with 1920, associated with the GAUDIET's Domain become from then the Castle LOUPIAC-GAUDIET.

This property belongs now to Marc DUCAU, associated with his nephew Daniel SANFOURCHE who assures the direction. Placed the South-West, the vineyard benefits from an exceptional period of sunshine.

His position in border of The Garonne offers the best conditions to the development of Botrytis cinerea (cryptogamic disease of the grape which develops with the combination of sun and morning humidity).

Both develop a wine with a certain typicality of the appellation so offering sharpness, elegance and fruity.

### TASTING

This wine makes us benefit from its light aromas calling apricot notes, fig and vanilla quince. On the palate, this Loupiac is lively and subtly sweet, he's supported by spicy notes.
